2014 marked another successful year for Hooked on Miracles who contributed \$400,000 to the Mining for Miracles campaign in support of B.C. Children's Hospital Foundation. This year, the Child & Family Research Institute completed the development of an Institutional BioBank at BC Children's Hospital.
